Legendary Sports Prints Announces Public Signing Great Grandsons of Josh Gibson and Babe Ruth to Sign “Josh & the Babe” Artwork

Plantsville, CT – March 24, 2008 – Legendary Sports Prints (LSP) announced that Sean Gibson, great grandson of the man that many regard as the greatest Negro League player, Josh Gibson and Brent Stevens, great grandson to slugger Babe Ruth, will both be signing a reproduction of a painting honoring their great grandfathers entitled “Josh and the Babe”. The signing will take place during the 5th through 8th innings of the Annual Civil Rights Game played this year between the New York Mets and Chicago White Sox on Saturday, March 29th at AutoZone Park in Memphis, Tennessee.

Mr. Gibson, President of the Josh Gibson Foundation, and Mr. Stevens, Co-President of BR3 Enterprises, LLC), collaborated with Legendary Sports Prints, a leader in high quality affordable sports art to create a painting that depicts Josh Gibson and Babe Ruth chatting before a game. Although such a meeting was improbable given the constraints of segregation during their era, art is able to transcend the realities of the time to bring together these two great baseball players on canvas. The image was painted by renowned sports artist Bill Purdom.

A special Major League Baseball Edition of the image, a mounted giclee print sized 8.5” x 11” on canvas, will be available for purchase at the stadium only. There will be no charge for the autographs by both gentlemen.
