Renowned Artist Al Sorenson Signs Long Term Agreement with LSP

LSP and Mr. Sorenson just released their seventh stadium collaboration, "Memorial Stadium", a depiction of the classic Baltimore stadium that opened in 1954, which played host to the Baltimore Orioles and Colts. The other stadiums depicted from Mr. Sorenson are Yankee Stadium, Wrigley Field, Ebbet's Field, Fenway Park, Busch Stadium and Tiger Stadium. Shibe Park (formerly located in Philadelphia, PA) and Comiskey Park (formerly located in Chicago, IL) are due to be released in May.
